What's new in Ethershield 1.0.9

Issues Solved

- An incompatibility with Mac and Linux clients that caused the filtering to not respond, and inaccurately block or allow websites has been resolved.
- Restarting the filter through the web interface no longer causes inaccurate filtering and crashing to occur.
- A categorization cache issue that would cause the device to crash after several days has been fixed.
- Application logging now contains more detailed timestamps.
- All references to SafeBrowse have been updated to our new name, InternetSafety.com.
- The following Program Control rules have been updated:
 - AOL Instant Messenger
 - MSN Instant Messenger
 - Yahoo! Instant Messenger
 - BitTorrent filesharing
- The following Program Control rules have been added:
 - Google Talk/Jabber Instant Messenger
 - MySpace Instant Messenger

Downloading and Installing

To download and install the update, just point your browser to <http://admin.ethershield.com>, and log in. Click on "Software Updates" and "Check for Updates". You should then see a screen showing you your current version details, as well as the details of the new version. All you need to do then, is click on the "Install Version 1.0.9" button. Your Ethershield will, download and install the update, and restart automatically. The entire process will only take a couple of minutes. During the update process, content control and Internet access may be temporarily unavailable.
