



# Ethershield 1.1.4 Release Notes

## What's new in Ethershield 1.1.4

### Issues Solved

- Updating a policy's allow or block site list no longer requires restarting the filter to take effect.
- Web interface stability has improved.
- Fixed password reset functionality. (Requires diagnostic code from support personnel).
- Opened SSH across all interfaces for easier field support. (Requires diagnostic code from support personnel).
- Included Putty SSH client on Ethershield. Once the update is installed, any client computer can download it from <http://admin.ethershield.com/putty.exe>
- Fixed log rendering memory problem that would occur while viewing large log files.
- Fixed Policy Delete functionality for all non-default policies.
- Fixed potential web restart bug occurring on some Ethershields.
- Updated policy and user naming restrictions.

### New Features

- A new web administration interface has been included. At this time the web administration portion should behave exactly like the previous one. However it has been updated to allow future changes to be made more flexibly.

## Downloading and Installing

To download and install the update, just point your browser to <http://admin.ethershield.com>, and log in. Click on "Software Updates" and "Check for Updates". You should then see a screen showing you your current version details, as well as the details of the new version. All you need to do then, is click on the "Install Version 1.1.4" button. Your Ethershield will, download and install the update, and restart automatically. Please allow several minutes to allow the Ethershield to complete the download as it is much larger than previous updates. During the update process, content control and Internet access may be temporarily unavailable.
