What's new in Ethershield 1.2.0

Issues Solved

- Fixed an issue on the denied page that caused inaccurate violated categories to display.
- Fixed some stability issues.
- Modified update process to verify user's account status.
- Fixed error message for unactivated Ethershields.
- Modified number of policy members and remote users displayed in the admin interface.
- Fixed network configuration permissions issue.

New Features

- Ethershield Remote (beta): With Ethershield Remote, you can administer your filtering policies on computers outside your network. This is beneficial for users with laptops that use them at home or on business trips. For more information, please download the beta user's guide and the Ethershield Remote client through the Ethershield admin interface.
- Added page in interface for viewing and modifying network routes: <http://admin.ethershield.com/routes>.
- Added ability for beta users to download specific firmware versions unavailable to other users.
- Updated logging system to be faster and more resource efficient.

Downloading and Installing

To download and install the update, just point your browser to <http://admin.ethershield.com>, and log in. Click on "Software Updates" and "Check for Updates". You should then see a screen showing you your current version details, as well as the details of the new version. All you need to do then, is click on the "Install Version 1.2.0" button. Your Ethershield will download and install the update, and restart automatically. The entire process may take a few minutes depending on your bandwidth. Do not close your browser window while your Ethershield is downloading the new firmware. During the update process, content control and Internet access may be temporarily unavailable.
