## What's new in Ethershield 1.2.2

### Issues Solved

- Fixed Ethershield Remote configuration issue for Public IP Address configuration type
- Fixed browser compatibility issue for applying network configurations.
- Fixed browser compatibility issues for configuring Ethershield Remote.
- Added error message if Ethershield fails to get information about an update.
- Fixed issue concerning SSH and Admin interface configurations for Ethershield Remote installations.
- Fixed Log Server start script error associated with Log Server problems in 1.2.0

### New Features

- Added ability to view status of Log Server, as well as ability to start Log Server if it goes down.
- Added functionality to register computers by IP address. This was added for installations with computers behind the Ethershield in another network segment. For example, if you have a routed subnet behind your Ethershield with no NAT, you may register statically assigned IP addresses. All other situations will still be registered by MAC address.

## Downloading and Installing

To download and install the update, just point your browser to <http://admin.ethershield.com>, and log in. Click on "Software Updates" and "Check for Updates". You should then see a screen showing you your current version details, as well as the details of the new version. All you need to do then, is click on the "Install Version 1.2.2" button. Your Ethershield will download and install the update, and restart automatically. The entire process may take a few minutes depending on your bandwidth. Do not close your browser window while your Ethershield is downloading the new firmware. During the update process, content control and Internet access may be temporarily unavailable.
